A MOTION TO APPROVE THE TRANSFERS IN THE TINDALL FARM FUND WAS MADE BY CARMONY, SECOND RIGGINS, VOTE 5-0.

A MOTION TO TABLE THE ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATION REQUEST FOR FUEL FOR THE SHELBY MANOR BUDGET UNTIL NEXT MONTH WAS MADE BY CARMONY, SECOND PARIS, VOTE 5-0.

MISCELLANEOUS:

BOB CARMONY DISCUSSED SOME MISUNDERSTANDINGS THAT HE THOUGHT EXISTED IN THE COMMUNITY. COMMISSIONER WADE SAID HE NEVER HEARD BACK FROM HUMAN SERVICES REGARDING THE GRANT APPLICATION.

COMMISSIONER WADE SAID AS FAR AS THE BILL PENDING BEFORE THE LEGISLATURE FOR FUNDING, ONE CAN ONLY ASSUME THAT THIS WILL NOT PASS. COMMISSIONER NIGH SAID IT WOULD ONLY IMPACT NEW APPLICANTS.

COUNCILMAN CARMONY ALSO WANTED TO CLARIFY THAT IF THE MANOR CLOSED THE FUNDS WOULD NOT BE USED FOR ANY CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN SUCH AS THE PARK, SOCCER FIELDS OR THE TECH PARK.


LOU DISSER FROM THE PUBLIC COMMENTED THAT HE DID NOT WANT TO SEE THE MANOR CLOSED. STEVE BIRD STATED HIS CONCERNS OF VANDALISM TO THE FARM IF IT IS NOT STAFFED. JOHN LEWIS (FORMER COMMISSIONER) STATED THAT THE COUNTY NEEDS TO TAKE CONSIDERATION FOR THE CEMETERY THAT IS ON THE GROUNDS, AND THE SHERIFF RANGE. MR. LEWIS STATED THAT THERE WAS NOT ENOUGH REVENUES TO KEEP THE MANOR OPEN, AND IF THEY COULD FIND REVENUES THIS YEAR WHAT WOULD HAPPEN NEXT YEAR?


