

THE SHELBY COUNTY COUNCIL MET ON TUESDAY MARCH 18, 2003 AT 7:00 PM. PRESENT WERE COUNCIL MEMBERS CARMONY, PARIS, MCCLAIN, EBERHART, HOPKINS, RIGGINS AND THE AUDITOR. COUNCILMAN KASTER WAS ABSENT.

**MINUTES:**

THE MINUTES WERE APPROVED AS PRESENTED, MOTION CARMONY, SECOND PARIS, VOTE 5-0, (MCCLAIN ABSTAINED).

**ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATIONS:**

**PUBLIC DEFENDER: WITHDRAWN.**

**PROBATION:**

A REQUEST TO TABLE WAS MADE BY PARIS, SECOND EBERHART, VOTE 6-0. COUNCILMAN PARIS SAID THEY NEED CLARIFICATION ON THE STATUE.

**ASSESSOR/DISCLOSURE FUND:**

A MOTION TO APPROVE \$2,500.00 FOR ASSESSOR TRAINING (179-01-03-92) WAS MADE BY EBERHART, SECOND CARMONY, VOTE 6-0.

A MOTION TO APPROVE \$2,000.00 (142-01-03-62) FOR INMATE DAMAGES TO JAIL PROPERTY WAS MADE BY PARIS, SECOND RIGGINS, VOTE 6-0.

**SHELBY MANOR:**

A MOTION TO APPROVE THE TRANSFERS OF \$.25 FROM 100-33-01-12 TO 100-33-03-51, \$293.85 FROM 100-33-01-16 TO 100-33-03-51, \$79.27 FROM 100-33-01-19 TO 100-33-03-51, \$591.15 FROM 100-33-01-20 TO 100-33-03-51 AND \$35.7. FROM 100-33-02-31 TO 100-33-03-51 WAS MADE BY CARMONY, SECOND MCCLAIN, VOTE 6-0

**MISCELLANEOUS:**

**APPOINTMENT TO SHELBYVILLE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT:**

A MOTION TO APPOINT PHIL GORRELL WAS MADE BY CARMONY, SECOND MCCLAIN, VOTE 6-0.

**SHERIFF REQUEST TO PURCHASE VEHICLES:**

SHERIFF DEBAUN SAID THAT HE HAS ORDERED 6 VEHICLES WITH A DELIVERY DATE IN MAY, AND WANTED TO PURCHASE ADDITIONAL VEHICLES BEFORE THE DEADLINE OF MID APRIL WITH A DELIVERY DATE IN JUNE.

SHERIFF DEBAUN SAID THE VENDOR WILL DEFER THE PAYMENT UNTIL TAX COLLECTIONS, BUT WILL CHARGE AN ADDITIONAL INTEREST RATE OF \$2,066.40 FOR THE 6 ADDITIONAL VEHICLES. SHERIFF DEBAUN SAID ENGINE REPLACEMENTS AND REPAIRS WOULD EAT UP THE COST OF THE INTEREST.

THE SHERIFF SAID THE VEHICLES NEED TO BE TAKEN OFF THE ROAD. SHERIFF DEBAUN SAID THE ADVANTAGE IS THAT IT SETS THE PRICE. COUNCILMAN HOPKINS SAID MAINTENANCE PAID FROM THE GENERAL FUND WAS AN ISSUE FOR THE OLDER VEHICLES. SHERIFF DEBAUN SAID WARRANTIES AND NEW TIRES WOULD BE AN ADVANTAGE.

COUNCILMAN HOPKINS SAID HIS CONCERN WAS THE CASH FLOW PROBLEM IN THE CUM CAPITAL FUND. COUNCILMAN MCCLAIN SAID THEY NEEDED TO GO AHEAD WITH THE ADDITIONAL PURCHASE OF SHERIFF VEHICLES. COUNCILMAN EBERHART REQUESTED THAT THE SHERIFF SEE IF ALL PAYMENTS COULD BE DEFERRED UNTIL TAX COLLECTIONS AND TO SEE WHAT THE INTEREST WOULD BE.

THE AUDITOR SAID THE OPTIONS AVAILABLE FOR FUNDS ARE FUND LOANS OR A TAX WARRANT, OR HB 1219 FOR PROVISIONAL BILLING. THE AUDITOR SAID THE BALANCE WAS \$41,972.00 AND THAT IS NOT GOING TO COVER THE PROFESSIONAL BUILDING PAYMENTS AND JAIL MAINTENANCE.

THE COUNCIL REQUESTED THAT THE SHERIFF KEEP PERSONAL MILES OFF THE VEHICLES. SHERIFF DEBAUN SAID THE DEPUTIES WOULD BE ASKED TO DOUBLE THEIR DUTY WITH PERSONAL MILES AND NO PAY RAISES.

COUNCILMAN EBERHART RECOMMENDED TO APPROVE THE PURCHASE OF THE VEHICLES BUT TO LEAVE IT OPEN-ENDED. A CONSENSUS VOTE WAS MADE OF 6-0.

**SHERIFF PAY RAISES:**

SHERIFF DEBAUN SAID THAT WITH THE RETIREMENT OF SCOTT ALVIS AND MIKE SHAW THERE ARE APPROPRIATIONS AVAILABLE TO USE TOWARDS THE PROMOTION OF A DETECTIVE SERGEANT AND A ROAD SERGEANT. THE SHERIFF WANTED A CONSENSUS THAT THE COUNCIL WOULD APPROVE OF SUCH A TRANSFER BEFORE THE MERIT BOARD APPROVES THE PROMOTION. COUNCIL PRESIDENT HOPKINS SAID TO PROCEED WITH THE PROMOTIONS.

A MOTION TO ADJOURN WAS MADE BY EBERHART, SECOND CARMONY, VOTE 6-0.
