THE SHELBY COUNTY COUNCIL MET AT 7:00 PM ON TUESDAY AUGUST 17, 2004. PRESENT WERE COUNCIL MEMBERS MCCLAIN, PARIS, CARMONY, SMITH, RIGGINS, EBERHART AND THE AUDITOR. COUNCILMAN KASTER WAS ABSENT.

MINUTES:

A MOTION TO APPROVE THE MINUTES WAS MADE BY CARMONY, SECOND PARIS, VOTE 6-0.

ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATIONS:

BUILD INDIANA FUNDS:

A MOTION TO APPROVE \$167,978.29 TOWARDS THE NEXT PHASE FOR FLAT ROCK DRAINAGE WAS MADE BY PARIS, SECOND CARMONY, VOTE 6-0.

EDIT:

A MOTION TO APPROVE \$35,000.00 FOR LIFE LONG LEARNING WAS MADE BY CARMONY, SECOND RIGGINS, VOTE 6-0.

COUNTY RESIDENT YALE SCHALK STATED THAT EMPLOYERS SHOULD TRAIN THEIR OWN EMPLOYEES AND THIS PROGRAM IS CREATING JUST ANOTHER LAYER OF BUREAUCRACY. MR. SCHALK STATED THAT HE FELT THAT THIS WAS NOT THE CORRECT USE OF EDIT FUNDS.






BUDGET DATES:
