SPECIAL SESSION:

THIS SPECIAL MEETING WAS CALLED DUE TO THE ADVERTISING BEING ADVERTISED ON THE MARCH 14, 2007 INSTEAD OF MARCH 7, 2007.

CORONER:

TOM LAUGHLIN PRESENTED THAT THE CORONERS OFFICE WAS OUT OF MONEY TO PAY BILLS AND EMPLOYEES. THIS BUDGET HAS BEEN CUT EVERY YEAR AND THE CORONER ALWAYS HAS TO COME BACK EVERY MONTH OF EVERY OTHER MONTH ASKING FOR MONEY ACCORDING TO COUNCIL MEMBER BRUNK.
