IN THE PAST 6 DAYS THE COUNTY HAS BEEN HIT WITH A TORNADO THAT WENT THROUGH WALDRON AND MIDDLETOWN ON TUESDAY JUNE 3, 2008. THE WHOLE COUNTY EXPERIENCED FLOODING WITH THE MOST DAMAGE IN THE SOUTHERN PART OF THE COUNTY. HOMELAND SECURITY HAS BEEN CALLED IN AND THE COUNTY HAS FILED WITH THE STATE DECLARATORY OF EMERGENCY. WITH ALL OF THIS AND THE WORK THAT NEEDS TO BE DONE, SMITH IS ASKING FOR A MOTION TO TRANSFER \$15,000.00 FROM THE RAINY DAY FUND TO THE EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT FUND.
