ADVISED HER THEY WOULD RELAY THE MESSAGE TO BOTH THE SHERIFF AND THE COMMISSIONERS.


MOTION TO ADJOURN WAS MADE BY DEBAUN SECOND BY CARMONY APPROVED 5-0
