

THE SHELBY COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MET AT 7:00 PM ON MONDAY SEPTEMBER 10, 2007. PRESENT WERE COMMISSIONERS LAIRD, NEWTON, MOHR AND THE DEPUTY AUDITOR.

**MINUTES:**

A MOTION TO APPROVE WAS MADE BY LAIRD, SECOND MOHR, VOTE 3-0.

**CLAIMS:**

A MOTION TO APPROVE PAYROLL CLAIMS WAS MADE BY MOHR, SECOND LAIRD, VOTE 3-0

**TRANSFERS AND ADDITIONALS:**

A MOTION TO APPROVE A TRANSFER REQUEST FROM THE HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT WAS MADE BY LAIRD, SECOND MOHR, VOTE 3-0. DIANE HAEHL STATED THAT THIS WAS TO FUND GENERAL LABOR FROM A TRUCK DRIVER POSITION. MRS. HAEHL STATED THAT EMPLOYEES HIRE IN AS PART TIME EMPLOYMENT 6 MONTHS BEFORE POTENTIAL FULL TIME.

**DIVERSIFIED M.A.I.L SERVICES:**

RUSS BRYANT GAVE A PRESENTATION ABOUT THE SERVICES THAT COULD BE PROVIDED AND THE COST SAVINGS TO THE COUNTY. MR. BRYANT SAID THEY ARE ENDORSED BY THE ASSOCIATION OF INDIANA COUNTIES.

MR. BRYANT EXPLAINED THE MAIL PICK UP PROCESS, CERTIFIED MAILINGS AND THE DELIVERY PROCESS. CAROL STOHR THE COUNTY CLERK EXPLAINED THAT THEY HAVE ONE YEAR LEFT ON THE CONTRACT. MR. BRYANT STATED THAT THE COUNTY COULD STILL SAVE MONEY BY PROCEEDING WITH CERTIFIED MAILINGS. THE COMMISSIONERS REQUESTED INFORMATION ON THE COST IF SEVERAL COUNTY OFFICE LOCATIONS ARE INCLUDED IN THIS SERVICE.

A MOTION TO TABLE UNTIL FURTHER INFORMATION IS OBTAINED WAS MADE BY LAIRD, SECOND MOHR, VOTE 3-0.

**LOG JAM IN LITTLE MARION:**

SCOTT GABBARD AND NOEL KRUGHOFF GAVE A PRESENTATION ON A LEVEL 3 LOG JAM IN LITTLE MARION. MR. GABBARD REQUESTED PERMISSION FROM THE COMMISSIONERS TO PROCEED WITH THE PERMIT APPLICATION IN THE COUNTY'S NAME. MRS. KRUGHOFF STATED THAT SOIL AND WATER WOULD PAY THE \$200.00 PERMIT FEE WITH DNR.

MR. GABBARD SAID THAT THE JAM IS VISIBLE IN AERIAL PHOTOGRAPHS AND IS PROBABLY THE LARGEST IN THE STATE. MR. GABBARD SAID THE WATER IS BACKING UP AND IS OVERFLOWING OUTSIDE OF THE CHANNEL AND IS CAUSING SOIL EROSION AND FOUNDATION ISSUES WITH PROPERTY OWNERS IN THE AREA.

MRS. KRUGHOFF STATED THAT FUNDS ARE AVAILABLE BUT WOULD HAVE TO BE REPAID. MRS. KRUGHOFF STATED THAT THERE ARE NO KNOWN GRANTS AT THIS TIME. A MOTION TO HAVE JOHN DEPREZ REVIEW THE PRELIMINARY APPLICATION PRIOR TO APPROVAL WAS MADE BY MOHR, SECOND LAIRD, VOTE 3-0.

ROBERT DILL A RESIDENT OF THE COUNTY STATED THAT HIS STEP SON SERVED IN THE MILITARY AND WAS KILLED IN AFGHANISTAN. MR. DILL STATED THAT MARTIN ESTATES APARTMENTS HAS NAMED A ROAD IN MEMORY OF HIM. MR. DILL PROPOSED TO THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

THAT A ROAD BE NAMED AFTER OUR COUNTY FALLEN HEROES FROM THE MILITARY AND THE FIRE AND POLICE DEPARTMENTS.
