**AMBULANCE BOARD:**

TOM LAUGHLIN REQUEST ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATION TO UPGRADE HEART MONITORS THAT THEY ACQUIRED FROM THE HOSPITAL. THE CITY OF SHELBYVILLE WILL PAY FOR ½ OF THE COST AND WE ARE ASKING THE COUNTY TO PAY FOR THE OTHER ½. THIS AMOUNT IS PROBABLY ON THE HIGH SIDE, SOMETIME THE VENDOR WILL OFFER 2 FOR 1 IN JUNE. WAITING TO SEE ON THIS AND THAT COULD SAVE AROUND \$7,000.00. FIRE DEPARTMENT DOESN'T HAVE THIS IN THEIR BUDGET FOR 2007. MOTION TO APPROVE BY LAIRD BASED ON THE APPROVAL OF THE COUNCIL, SECOND BY MOHR APPROVED 3-0

**COUNTY ASSESSOR:**

LYNN IS REQUESTING TO BRING IN ANOTHER FULL TIME PERSON INTO THE OFFICE TO HELP OUT WITH REDUCING TO DOLLARS SPENT TO HAVE ACCURATE ASSESSMENT DO THE OUTSIDE ASSESSING THAT SHOULD BE DONE BY THE ASSESSOR AND DEPUTY ASSESSOR. WE CURRENTLY PAY AROUND \$80,000.00 TO \$100,000.00 TO THEM AND \$400.00 A DAY FOR THEM TO HELP OUT. BY HIRING THIS FULL TIME PERSON WE WOULD PAY \$20,000.00 A YEAR AND \$34,138 WITH BENEFITS. WE WOULD NOT NEED TO CREATE A POSITION FOR THIS BECAUSE THE PREVIOUS ASSESSOR ALREADY HAD THE POSITION BUT WHEN THIS PERSON QUIT SHE NEVER

REPLACED HER. THIS WOULD BE PAID OUT OF THE REASSESSMENT FUND AND WOULD SAVE MONEY. WE WON'T BE ABLE TO SEE IT THIS YEAR, DUE TO BEING BEHIND AND CATCHING UP. MOTION MADE BY MOHR TO APPROVE BASED ON THE APPROVAL FROM THE COUNCIL SECOND BY LAIRD. APPROVED 3-0

**MAINTENANCE:**

FRANK REQUESTED TO PURCHASE A NEW COMPRESSOR FOR OUTSIDE UNIT. THIS IS THE SECOND TIME WE HAVE HAD TO REPLACE AND NEXT TIME WOULD LIKE TO HAVE TRANE COME OUT AND GIVE QUOTE TO REPLACE WHOLE THING. WE HAVE NOTHING BUT PROBLEMS SINCE INSTALLED. COST IS \$12,386.55 REQUEST TO APPROVE BY LAIRD SECOND BY MOHR APPROVED 3-0.

FRANK ALSO REQUEST TO PURCHASE NEW LAWN MOWER. THE OTHER ONE IS 9 YEARS OLD AND NEEDS A LOT OF WORK DONE. LEAKING OIL REALLY BAD. FRANK OBTAINED 3 QUOTES-MIDWAY POWER, JOHN DEERE AND HARRISON STREET. WHEREAS: The Shelby County Sheriff's Department provides an unceasing vital public service.






**"PEACE OFFICER'S MEMORIAL DAY"**


