


THE SHELBY COUNTY COUNCIL MET AT 1:00 PM ON THURSDAY SEPTEMBER 01, 2005 FOR THE 2006 BUDGET PUBLIC HEARING. PRESENT WERE COUNCIL MEMBERS EBERHART, PARIS, GRUBBS, RIGGINS, FUCHS, CARMONY AND THE AUDITOR. COUNCIL MAN SMITH WAS NOT PRESENT.


COUNCIL PRESIDENT EBERHART OPENED THE PUBLIC HEARING; A MOTION TO DISPENSE READING THE PUBLIC HEARING ADVERTISEMENT WAS MADE BY PARIS, SECOND RIGGINS, VOTE 5-0 (CARMONY WAS LATE).


THE FLOOR WAS OPENED UP TO PUBLIC COMMENTS. DWAIN LAIRD SAID HE OPPOSED TO THE PERCENTAGE AMOUNT OF EDIT FUNDS USED TO FUND THE JAIL DEBT. MR. LAIRD SPOKE OF THE LOST OF FIT, EXCISE AND CAGIT REVENUES TO THE TOWNSHIP TAXING UNITS DUE TO INCREASED TAXING LEVY OF THE COUNTY. MR. LAIRD STATED THAT HE MAY APPEAL FURTHER THIS YEAR.




A MOTION TO ADJOURN WAS MADE BY PARIS, SECOND GRUBBS, VOTE 6-0.
