

THE SHELBY COUNTY COUNCIL MET ON TUESDAY OCTOBER 08, 2002. PRESENT WAS COUNCIL MEMBERS EBERHART, KARMIRE, RIGGINS, HOPKINS, KASTER, CARMONY, MCCLAIN AND THE AUDITOR.

**MINUTES:**

THE MINUTES WERE APPROVED AS PRESENTED MOTION KASTER, SECOND HOPKINS, VOTE 6-0 (MCLAIN ABSTAINED). THE SALARY ORDINANCE MINUTES AND THE BUDGET MINUTES WERE TABLED UNTIL THE NOVEMBER COUNCIL MEETING, MOTION KARMIRE, SECOND MCCLAIN, VOTE 7-0.

**ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATIONS:**

**COMMISSIONERS:**

\$130,383.83 WAS REQUESTED FUNDING FOR THE REST OF 2002 FOR THE COMMISSIONERS BUDGET. DIANE HAEHL SAID SHE STILL THOUGHT THE ESTIMATE WAS TOO LOW. DIANE SAID SHE THOUGHT SHE WOULD HAVE ENOUGH FOR THE MONTH IF SHE DID NOT PAY PATIENTS AND INMATE THEIR SECOND PAYMENT. COUNCILMAN KARMIRE MOTIONED TO TABLE THE REQUEST UNTIL NEXT MONTH.

THE AUDITOR STATED THAT THE CORONER WOULD NEED AT LEAST \$15,000.00 FOR THE REST OF 2002 TO 100-07-03-11. A MOTION TO APPROVE WAS MADE BY KARMIRE, SECOND MCCLAIN, VOTE 7-0.

**SUPERIOR COURT II:**

COUNCIL KARMIRE MOTIONED TO LET THE ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATION REQUEST IN THE AMOUNT OF \$3000.00 DIE, AND APPROVE THE JURORS FEES IN THE AMOUNT OF \$7,000.00, SECOND RIGGINS, VOTE 7-0.

**MISCELLANEOUS:**

COUNCIL PRESIDENT CARMONY ASKED THE AUDITOR THE PROCEDURE FOR THE APPEAL PROCESS AND ASKED IF ANY HELP WAS NEEDED OUTSIDE COUNTY GOVERNMENT. THE AUDITOR STATED THAT THE COUNCIL AND THE AUDITOR COULD HANDLE THE APPEAL WITH THE STATE TAX BOARD. THE AUDITOR STATED THAT WHEN SHE RECEIVES NOTIFICATION FROM THE STATE OF THE DATE AND TIME SHE WOULD FORWARD THE INFORMATION ONTO THE COUNCIL.

**SALARY ORDINANCE:**

A MOTION TO TABLE UNTIL THE NOVEMBER MEETING WAS MADE BY KARMIRE, SECOND MCCLAIN, VOTE 7-0.

**JANITORIAL CONTRACT:**

COMMISSIONER MOHR STATED THAT THEY HAVE ONE JANITOR LEAVING AND ONE DISSATISFIED THAT WOULD LEAVE TWO FOR ALL MAINTENANCE AND OUTSIDE WORK.

MR. BURCH SAID UNLESS THE COUNCIL WOULD CONSIDER FUNDING THE JANITORIAL SERVICE CONTRACT THE STANDARDS WOULD HAVE TO BE LOWERED FROM A MAJOR CLEANING ONCE A WEEK TO A WALK THROUGH TOUCH-UP.

**I-69 RESOLUTION:**

THE COUNCIL DECIDED THERE WAS NO REASON FOR THEM TO ADDRESS BY RESOLUTION THE 1-69 CORRIDOR AS REQUESTED BY VIGO COUNTY.
