MINUTES:

MOTION TO APPROVE THE MINUTES FROM JUNE 27, 2011 WAS MADE BY NIGH, SECOND BY MOHR, APPROVED 3-0

JOHN DEPRez / REPEAL ORDINANCE:

JOHN PRESENTED TO THE COMMISSIONER THE NEW LAW WITH HAND GUNS HAS CHANGED AS OF JULY 1, 2011. ANYONE CARRYING A FIREARMS PERMIT IS NOW ALLOWED TO CARRY THEIR FIREARM WITH THEM INTO ANY BUILDING AS LONG AS THE BUILDING DOESN'T HAVE A COURT IN IT. WITH THIS NEW LAW DEPRez SUGGESTED TO THE COMMISSIONER THEY SHOULD REPEAL ORDINANCE 2000-06 ADOPTED ON MAY 17, 2000, BANNING ANYONE FROM CARRYING A FIREARM INTO THE GOVERNMENT BUILDINGS. 


NEWTON WANTED TO WELCOME THE NEW PLAN COMMISSIONER SAM BOOTH.


