

THE SHELBY COUNTY COMMISSIONERS MET AT 5:00 P.M. ON MONDAY DECEMBER 23, 2013. PRESENT WERE COMMISSIONERS NIGH, MOHR, PARKER, COUNTY ATTORNEY AND COUNTY AUDITOR

MINUTES:

DECEMBER 16, 2013 – MOTION TO APPROVE MADE BY PARKER SECOND BY MOHR, APPROVED 3-0

DECEMBER 19, 2013 – MOTION TO APPROVE WAS MADE BY PARKER, SECOND BY MOHR, APPROVED 3-0

KAREN GERALDS / 700 S VACATE:

KAREN ASKED THE COMMISSIONERS IF ANYTHING HAD BEEN RESOLVED YET ON THE TURN AROUND FOR THE SCHOOL BUS AT THE END OF 700 S, DEPREZ APOLOGIZED AND ADVISED THAT THE COMMISSIONERS HAD MET WITH MR. NIEMAN AND HE IS ALLOWING THE COUNTY TO PUT A TURN AROUND IN HIS BARN LOT FOR THE SCHOOL BUS AND SNOW PLOW. GENE NIEMAN (MR. NIEMAN'S DAUGHTER) ADVISED THAT NO ONE HAD TALKED TO ME NIEMAN ABOUT THIS AND HE HAS NOT AGREED TO ANYTHING. JOHN ADVISED THAT IS WHAT HE HAD BEEN TOLD BY THE COMMISSIONERS AND THAT IS WHY THIS HAS BEEN SAID. MS. NIEMAN ASKED WHO THEY SPOKE WITH AND THE COMMISSIONERS ADVISED IT WAS PAUL NIEMAN, GENE THEN ADVISED HE DOESN'T OWN THIS LAND. JOHN THEN ADVISED THEY ARE GOING TO NEED TO TAKE ANOTHER LOOK AT THIS. AT THIS TIME MRS. GERALD ASKED IF THEY WERE GOING TO RE-OPEN THE ROAD CLOSURE PART, SINCE MR. FANSLER DIDN'T DO WHAT HE AGREED TO. DEPREZ ADVISED NO. MR. GERALDS AGAIN OFFERED HIS LAND TO TURN AROUND IN. THEY ARE CONCERNED BECAUSE OF THE INCLINE OF THE AREA. THE BUS DRIVER MICHELLE PARKER ADVISED THAT SHE HAS BEEN DRIVING THIS ROUTE FOR 11 YEARS AND ADVISED THERE IS NO WAY A BUS CAN TURN AROUND IN THIS AREA. RIGHT NOW THEY BRING THE KIDS DOWN TO THE END OF THE ROAD AND SHE HAS TO STOP IN THE MIDDLE OF THE ROAD AND THIS IS NOT A GOOD SPOT TO STOP BECAUSE IT IS ON A HILL AND YOU CAN'T SEE. ALL SHE IS ASKING IS THE GATE IS OPENED AGAIN, SO SHE CAN TURN AROUND. J T EDWARDS ADVISED IT IS VERY DANGEROUS LOADING AND UNLOADING THE CHILDREN IN HE MIDDLES OF THE INTERSECTION AT 600 & 700. BOBBY LINDSEY ADVISED SHE HAS CHILDREN ON THIS BUS ROUTE AND DIDN'T KNOW ANYTHING ABOUT IT UNTIL SHE WAS ASKED TO COME TO THE MEETING ON FRIDAY. THIS PUTS MY CHILDREN IN DANGER BECAUSE THEY STOP IN THE MIDDLE OF THE ROAD AND IT IS VERY DANGEROUS RIGHT THERE. SHE ALSO ADVISED SHE THOUGHT THE COMMISSIONERS SHOULD HAVE SENT LETTERS TO ALL PARENTS LETTING THEM KNOW ABOUT THIS. JOYCE SIPES ANOTHER BUS DRIVER SAID SHE WENT DOWN THERE HER SELF AND SAID NO BUS OR SNOW PLOW COULD TURN AROUND THERE. DEPREZ ADVISED THIS NEW ISSUE WITH MR. NIEMAN'S PROPERTY WAS JUST BROUGHT TO THE COMMISSIONERS ATTENTION TODAY AND THEY ARE WORKING ON SOMETHING ELSE. MINDY EDWARDS SAID SHE LIVES IN THE FIRST HOUSE ON, SHE DOESN'T HAVE A PROBLEM WITH THE ROAD BEING CLOSED SHE JUST WANTS THE LAND OWNER TO DO WHAT HE ADVISED HE WOULD DO. MAKE THE TURN AROUND BIG ENOUGH FOR THE BUS AND PLOWS. KENT SMITH ASKED THAT UNTIL THIS IS RESOLVED COULD THE COUNTY AT LEAST SEND A SMALL TRUCK DOWN TO PLOW THE ROAD. DEPREZ WAS ASKED IF THERE WERE ANY LAW SUITS PENDING AT THIS TIME. DEPREZ ADVISED NO. MRS. GERALDS ASKED HOW SOON THIS WOULD BE PUT BACK ON THE AGENDA. THE COMMISSIONERS ADVISED NEXT MONDAY, THEY WILL DO THEIR BEST TO COME UP WITH ANOTHER SOLUTION BY THEN. THEY HAVE BEEN WORKING HARD ON THIS AND WILL CONTINUE UNTIL FIXED.
