

**MINUTES:**

MOTION TO APPROVE MINUTES FROM MAY 19, 2014 WAS MADE BY PARKER, SECOND BY MOHR, APPROVED 3-0

**SHERIFF:**

THE COMMISSIONERS GAVE SHERIFF BOWLBY A HAND WRITTEN LETTER LAST WEEK, REFERENCING AN ADDRESS IN THE 7600 BLOCK OF 600 WEST, THE LETTER DIDN'T SPECIFY THE COMPLAINT, BUT THE SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT HAS BEEN THERE DURING THE DAY AND NIGHT AND NO ONE IS EVER HOME. THE PROPERTY IS CLEANED UP VERY NEAT, THEY WILL CONTINUE TO TRY AND LOCATE THEM AND SEE WHAT THE COMPLAINT IS. THEY WILL ALSO TRY TO GET IN CONTACT WITH SOME NEIGHBORS.

SHERIFF BOWLBY ALSO LET THE COMMISSIONERS KNOW THAT THEY DID DO THE TRAFFIC STUDY ON 600 W FROM MICHIGAN ROAD TO 1100 N AND THEY ARE HAVING TROUBLE GETTING THE INFORMATION OFF OF THE MACHINE, THEY ARE CHECKING INTO THE SOFTWARE AND THE COMPUTER AND WILL CONTINUE TO WORK ON IT. BUT AT THIS TIME SHERIFF BOWLBY DOESN'T SEEM TO THINK THAT 5 MPH IS GOING TO DO ANYTHING. COMMISSIONER MOHR ASKED IF THEY COULD POST THE SPEED LIMIT OF 55 MPH OR WHAT WOULD THE SHERIFF SUGGEST. BOWLBY SUGGEST MAYBE PUTTING THE RADAR TRAILER OUT AND SEE IF THAT HELPS. HE WOULD NEED A LEVEL PLACE WITH POSSIBLE ELECTRICITY, MOHR ADVISED THAT HE WILL LOOK INTO IT AND GET BACK WITH HIM.

BOWLBY ADVISED THEY HAVE BEEN HAVING SOME ISSUES WITH PERSONAL IN THE JAIL. THEY HAVE POSTED A JOB FOR ASST. JAIL COMMANDER BECAUSE HE PROMOTED THE ASST. TO CAPTAIN AND THE RETIREMENT OF THE CURRENT JAIL COMMANDER. HE HAS HAD THE JOB POSTED FOR 15 DAYS AND HAS ONLY RECEIVED ONE APPLICATION, BUT THIS PERSON'S SPOUSE WORKS IN THE JAIL. BOWLBY ADVISED HE HAS MET WITH OUR HR DIRECTOR, CONTACTED THE SHERIFF'S LEGAL COUNCIL AND HAS TALKED WITH THE COUNTY ATTORNEY AND THEY HAVE COME UP WITH RE-WRITE THE JOB DESCRIPTION AND REMOVE THE SPOUSE FROM THE DIRECT SUPERVISION OF THE ASST. COMMANDER. BOWLBY WOULD LIKE THE PERMISSION FROM THE COMMISSIONERS TO DO SO. MOTION TO APPROVE WAS MADE BY MOHR, SECOND BY PARKER, APPROVED 3-0

**GARY MOODY / SOLID WASTE CONCERNS:**

MR. MOODY CAME BEFORE THE COMMISSIONERS TONIGHT WITH CONCERN ABOUT THE SOLID WASTE BOARD AND THE CONFLICT OF INTEREST WITH AN EMPLOYEE OF THE SOLID WASTE. MR. MOODY HAD CONCERNS ON WHY NONE OF THE COMMISSIONERS EVER RESPONDED TO HIS LETTER HE MAILED TO THEM IN OCTOBER 2013. HE ASKED WHY THEY NEVER RESPONDED AND THEY ADVISED THEY DON'T SEE A PROBLEM WITH IT. MS. CARPENTER IS ONE OF THE BEST DIRECTORS WE HAVE HAD IN THERE AND HAS INCREASED OUR SOLID WASTE INTAKE OVER THE PAST YEARS. MR. MOODY ADVISED THAT BY HER WORKING FOR SOLID WASTE AND THE LAND FILL, THIS GIVES THE LAND FILL THE COUNTY'S BUSINESS AND THERE FOR INCREASES THEIR PROFIT AND THE COUNTY GETS A KICK BACK FROM THE TAKE IN. MOHR ADVISED THAT WHEN THEY FIRST STARTED THE OIL RECYCLE THEY STARTED WITH A 500 GL TANK AND NOW THEY ARE USING A 1,100 GL TANK AND ARE FILL IT FASTER THEN WHEN WE FIRST STARTED. MOHR ALSO ADVISED WE MEET ALL STATE REQUIREMENTS AND FEELS THAT MR. MOODY NEEDS TO FIND SOMETHING ELSE TO OCCUPY HIS TIME. THERE IS NO PROBLEM WITH SOLID WASTE.

THERE BEING NO FURTHER BUSINESS TO COME BEFORE THE BOARD. A MOTION TO ADJOURN WAS MADE BY PARKER SECOND BY MOHR, APPROVED 3-0
