

ORDINANCE NO. 2015-22

AN ORDINANCE to amend Ordinance 2007-2 adopted by the Shelby County Council on March 20, 2007.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Shelby County Council of Shelby County, Indiana, as follows:


SECTION 1: Purpose. AN ORDINANCE to amend Section 1 of Ordinance 2007-2 as follows:

1. All passenger vehicles, trucks with a declared gross weight that does not exceed 11,000 pounds and all motorcycles, **and motor driven cycles**, registered in Shelby County, that are now subject to an excise tax shall continue to be subject to an annual excise surtax; however, beginning January 1, 2008, the excise tax for all such vehicles shall be a flat fee of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00), which shall be paid with the registration of said motor vehicles.


SECTION 2: Effective Date. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon adoption by the Shelby County Council.



members of the Shelby County Council.





ORDINANCE 2007 - 2

An Ordinance to create Shelby County's Excise Surtax and Wheel Tax

WHEREAS, IC 6-3.5-4-2 authorizes the County Council to impose, by ordinance, a local option annual Excise Surtax of not less than 2% (two percent) or more than 10% (ten percent) or at a specific amount of at least \$7.50 (seven dollars fifty cents) and not more than twenty-five dollars (\$25) on each motor vehicle registered in the County and subject to the annual excise tax; and,

WHEREAS, IC 6-3.5-5-2 authorizes the County Council to impose, by ordinance, a local option annual Wheel Tax of not less than \$5.00 (Five Dollars) nor more than \$40.00 (Forty Dollars) on each of 7 (seven) classifications of motor vehicles, not subject to the excise tax, registered in the County; and,

WHEREAS, IC 6-3.5-4 & 5 require that the local option Excise Surtax and local option Wheel Tax be imposed concurrently; and,

WHEREAS, Shelby County desires additional funds to support the safe, all-weather operation of the road and street system in Shelby County,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF SHELBY COUNTY INDIANA, THAT

1. All passenger vehicles, trucks with a declared gross weight that does not exceed 11,000 pounds and all motorcycles, registered in Shelby County, that are now subject to an excise tax shall continue to be subject to an annual excise surtax; however, beginning January 1, 2008, the excise tax for all such vehicles shall be a flat fee of twenty five dollars (\$25.00), which shall be paid with the registration of said motor vehicles.
2. Beginning January 1, 2008, all of the following seven classes of motor vehicles, registered in Shelby County, shall be subject to an annual, Wheel Tax as set out in the following schedule, to be paid with the registration of said motor vehicles:

Motor Vehicle	Annual
<u>Classification</u>	<u>Wheel Tax</u>
(a) Buses	\$40.00
(b) Recreation Vehicles	\$40.00
(c) Semitrailers	\$40.00
(d) Tractors	\$40.00
(e) Light trailers (< 12,000 lb.)	\$25.00
(f) Heavy trailers (12,000 + lb.)	\$40.00
(g) Trucks (both heavy and light)	\$40.00

As provided by IC 6-3.5-5-4, the following motor vehicles are exempt from the annual Wheel Tax:


- vehicles owned by the State of Indiana, a state agency of this state or a political subdivision of this state,
- buses owned and operated by a religious or non-profit youth organization and used to haul persons to religious services or for the benefit of their members,


3. All of the Excise Surtax and Wheel Tax collected on motor vehicles registered in Shelby County shall be distributed, as provided in IC 6-3.5-4 and 5-1 et. seq. and 6-3.5-5-1 et. seq., to the County, City and Town Units of Shelby County by the County Auditor and shall be used only to construct, reconstruct, repair, or maintain streets and roads under their jurisdiction.


