



*WHEREAS*, as Governor of the State of Indiana, I am directed by state law to commission  
certain officers designated in the Constitution of the State of Indiana;

NOW, THEREFORE, IN THE NAME AND BY THE AUTHORITY OF  
THE STATE OF INDIANA,

I hereby issue this commission, which authorizes the aforesaid individual to execute and perform the duties of this office according to law, to have and to hold the office, with all the rights and emoluments legally pertaining to the office until a successor has been duly elected and qualified to this office, being conditioned upon the individual taking the required oath to faithfully discharge the duties of this office and to support the Constitution of the United States and the Constitution of the State of Indiana, all as provided by law.
